



Sagebrush Songbird Survey Training Details

The training will be dedicated to simulating the actual experience of running a survey in the field. We will have experts on hand to help with field identification for many of the species we will encounter and everyone will get lots of practice using GPS units and filling out the necessary forms. Plus, similar to last year, there will be posters set up where you can sign up for particular survey sites. **Please note that the field training Day 2 is OPTIONAL.**

Training is free but there are a few ancillary expenses, food and hotel. If you are new to the project please [register to volunteer as a CERVIS WDFW volunteer](#). The nearest hotels for Friday and Saturday nights are in Ephrata, 30+ minutes from Nature Conservancy's Moses Coulee Field Station.

Logistics: The training site, TNC's Moses Lake Field Station, is **remote** with limited cell service.

Please Bring to Training:

- A FULL tank of gas. Nearest gas is Ephrata.
- Personal calendar for April, May, June
- Binoculars and/or scope.
- GPS unit (if you have one)
- Clipboard
- Carpool if possible
- \$10 per day for food. We will provide coffee, tea, snacks, lunch and dinner.
- Mileage and hotel reimbursement available
